The bride is the younger daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Brady of Marmora and the groom is the son of Mr. and Mrs. James Webster of Burlington.

The bride is a nursing science graduate of the University of Ottawa, and is now on the staff at the University Hospital, London. The groom graduated in medicine from the University of Western Ontario, and is at present a resident physician in London.

The bride wore a gown of classic simplicity in champagne nylon matte jersey, falling in soft folds from a narrow yoke. A hooded cape completed her ensemble. She carried a bouquet of green baby orchids and fern.
