

In the 1871 Ontario Census they were 14 BURNS family members reported living in the Province of Ontario. All of the BURNS had come from either England or Ireland and all had settled in the Townships of Hastings County.

Hastings County was created by an Act of Parliament in 1792. Each township that was surveyed was to have had over 60,000 acres, but each township lot would be 200 acres. Between the years 1790 and 1800, six townships had been surveyed and were ready for settlement.

Marmora, Madoc and Elzevir & Grimsthorpe Townships (Actinolite) were added to Hastings County in 1821. It was during the following years that the Crown offered lots for sale in many of these sections of Hastings County in the hope of enticing new settlers to these remote areas.

Farming was the main industry that supported these growing communities before 1830. Mines opened, flourished and closed in a regular manner in many of the townships.

A favourite line the miners in the area often heard was; " Due to overstocking in the United States, suspension of all activity appears to be reasonable ".

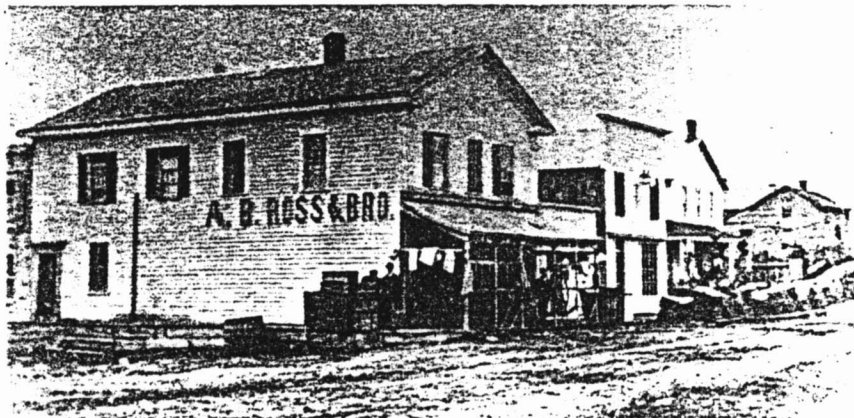
" Wanted Miners and Labourers

As in many of the small townships, lumbering filled the economic gap left when the mines lay idle. During the years 1850 and 1860 the large lumber companies started a systematic stripping of the valuable mature trees in many sections of Hastings County.

The following from Ruth Tierney's " Echoes from the Past " book describing the many villages and towns in Hastings County speaks volumes;

" The remains of deserted farms, old mills and abandoned mines are plentiful. Coupled with the second growth of trees, open water-filled pits gouged deep in the earth, and the structural distinctness of buildings that still stand. Roads that twist and turn through valleys and over hills in snakelike fashion give testimony to the isolation of the pioneers in parts of Hastings from the balance of civilization ".

Six of the eight BURNS children were born in Ireland between the years of 1807 and 1819. Simon, the second youngest, was born in the Province of Ontario in 1828. John, the youngest was born in the Province of Quebec in 1836. John would later move to the Actinolite area and by 1871 was employed as a tavernkeeper.



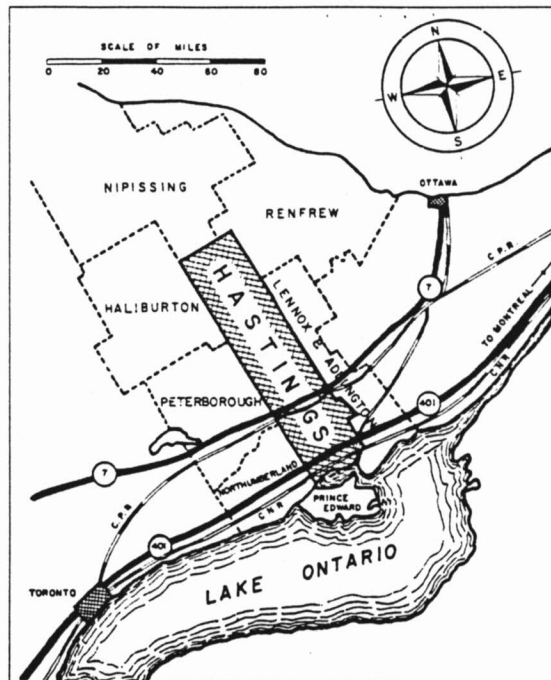
Madoc at the time of the gold rush showing the store of A.B. Ross & Brother, wholesale and retail merchants. Because the hotels were full, Belleville interests met in this store to set up the Madoc Mining Company, one of the players in the struggle to control the Richardson site. (Madoc Mercury, 24 November 1866).

Gold had been discovered in the Eldorado / Madoc area in 1866. Hotels and taverns were springing up to accommodate the miners. In 1856 a stage-coach-run was making weekly trips from Belleville to Madoc. By 1867, four horse-drawn stage coaches left Madoc daily as miners, geologists, engineers and government representatives came to Madoc from border States and each Province.

The years of 1819 and 1853 suggest that separate BURNS families had come to Canada each at different times. Perhaps one family left early, settled in their new country and when land , homes and money was available sent for the other BURNS members. The latter BURNS family members may have fled Ireland when the potato famine occurred in the 1840's. More than 100,000 Irish citizens came to Canada in 1847 alone. They came from poetic county names such as Limerick , Tipperary, Clare and Cork.

The complete lack of names of elder BURNS strongly suggest that several family members may have settled and remained in the Province of Quebec.

Transportation from all European countries was by ship to either Montreal or Quebec cities. From there immigrants travelled down the St. Lawrence River to the city of Kingston and then on to Belleville, Ontario.



Following is a complete list of the eight BURNS from the 1871 Ontario Census that may have left Ireland for Canada before the year 1828;

JOHN BURNS - born 1807, Ireland

 - employed as a farmer in 1871.

THOMAS BURNS - born 1808, Ireland
 - settled in the Hungerford Township
 (Tweed, Stoco)

NOTE;

A residence of Tweed, Clarence Benn, who was born in 1899, recalls his old friend Bill Anderson who used to fire the boilers and engines at his grist-mills. Bill often kept game roosters, who on occasion Killed Mrs. BURNS' chickens. As Clarence recalls " a fella could always get a good feed of chicken at old Bill's house ".

Descendants of William BURNS/BYRNES & Ellen/Helen SMITH

- 1 **William BURNS/BYRNES** was born 13 Jun 1837 in Carlow co, Ireland, and died 26 Oct 1900, most likely in Madoc twp, Hastings, Ontario. He married **Ellen/Helen SMITH** 7 Feb 1876 in Hungerford twp, Hastings, Ontario. She was born about 1850 in Upper Canada [Ontario], and died 8 Jul 1914 in Madoc twp, Hastings, Ontario. William was buried in St Edmunds RC Cemetery, Stoco, Ontario. It has not been determined where Ellen/Helen was buried.

The William BURNS/BYRNES family lived in the southeast corner of Madoc Township, near Elzevir and Hungerford.

A search has not been undertaken for the BURNS/BYRNES family on the 1891 Canada Census.

William's death does not appear to have been registered with the Province of Ontario. His remains were buried in the BYRNES family plot in St Edmunds RC Cemetery at Stoco in Hungerford Township.

A search has not been undertaken to locate a death notice or an obituary for William BYRNES.

Ellen/Helen was listed as a widow on the 1901 Canada Census in Madoc Township with her four known children.

The family could not be located on the 1911 Canada Census. Do you know if some of the returns for Madoc Township might be missing from the scanned images on the Library and Archives website?

The death registration for Ellen states that she died in Madoc Township. The informant on the registration was her son John of Madoc Township. It has not been determined where her remains were interred.

A search has not been undertaken to locate a death notice or an obituary for Ellen/Helen BYRNES.

Children of William BURNS and Ellen SMITH were:

- 2 **Mary BURNS/BYRNES**, born about 1876, in either Hungerford or Madoc twp, Hastings, Ontario.

Mary was listed with her mother and brothers on the 1901 Canada Census.

A search of Ontario marriage registration indexes has not located any mention of a possible marriage for Mary.

A search of Ontario death registration indexes has not located any mention of a possible death for Mary.

- 3 **Ellen/Helen BURNS/BYRNES**, born about 1880 in Madoc twp, Hastings, Ontario; died 25 Dec 1926 in Tweed, Hastings, Ontario. She married **John Joseph JOHNSTON**; born 23 Apr 1882 in Hungerford twp, Hastings, Ontario; died 11 Jun 1947 in Hungerford twp, Hastings, Ontario. Ellen/Helen and John were buried in St Edmunds RC Cemetery, Stoco, Ontario.

We are quite familiar with Ellen/Helen and her husband John Joseph JOHNSTON of Stoco, Hastings, Ontario.

No death notice or obituary has been located in the Tweed "News" for Ellen/Helen JOHNSTON.

- 4 **John BURNS/BYRNES**, born about 1882 in Ontario. He married **Mary ERWIN/IRVING** 23 Nov 1909 in Madoc Village, Hastings, Ontario; born about 1888 most likely in Elzevir twp, Hastings, Ontario.

John BURNS/BYRNES was consistently listed as a farmer in Madoc Township.

Mary ERWIN/IRVING was a daughter of David ERWIN/IRVING and Jane BURNS of the Actinolite area of Elzevir Township.

When John travelled to Niagara Falls, New York looking for work in 1925, he left behind his wife Mary at Madoc.

Three years later, Mary's brother John Stewart ERWIN travelled to Niagara Falls for the same reason. He was destined for his "friend" John BURNS of Niagara Falls.

John BURNS/BYRNES, Mary BURNS/BYRNES and John Stewart ERWIN could not be positively located on the 1930 United States Census at Niagara Falls, New York or elsewhere in the USA.

It is not known if John and Mary stayed in the United States, or returned to the Madoc area.

- 5 **Lawrence "Larry" BURNS/BYRNES**, born 30 Nov 1885 in Madoc twp, Hastings, Ontario; died between 3-4 Nov 1917 in Belgium.

Lawrence BYRNES enlisted as a single man in the First World War 15 Dec 1915. He was a farmer in Madoc Township at the time of his enlistment.

Lawrence died at the beginning of Nov 1917, one of almost 16,000 Canadians who died during the Second Battle of Passchendaele.

A search has not been undertaken to locate a death notice or an obituary for Lawrence BYRNES.

Detailed information is only available on JOHN BURNS and his wife JESSIE CARPENTER who married and settled in Marmora Township.

Since this report is mainly concerned with the BURNS family members that settled and remained in Marmora, we now hope that someone else will take the genealogical torch and continue the search.



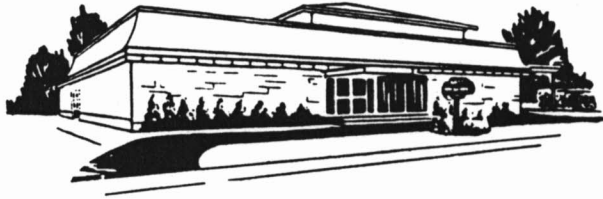

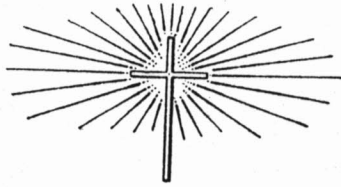
