OUR LOYALIST CONNECTION - - - THOMAS DEMPSEY and his wife, MARY LAWSON ...

THOMAS DEMPSEY	m.	MARY LAWSON in 1782

THOMAS DEMPSEY was the youngest son of MARK DEMPSEY and his wife, ELIZABETH CARROLL, and he was born in the Manse of General Schuyler at Hackensack, Bergen County, New Jersey. Mark Dempsey was General Schuyler's secretary and he married Elizabeth Carroll in 1746. Mark died circa 1784.

At the outbreak of the American Revolution in 1775, THOMAS DEMPSEY was drafted into the Continental or Rebel Army. After one year he was discharged (or escaped) and joined the Royal Standard. New York was evacuated in 1788 and Thomas came to Canada (to Napanee) with his wife, Mary, and their three children, Sarah, Ann and Peter, and Mary's parents.

MARY LAWSON DEMPSEY was the daughter of PETER and SARAH LAWSON and they had their property and possessions confiscated by the Rebel forces because of Peter's Royalist activities in the Hackensack Valley, Bergen County, New Jersey.

In 1789 THOMAS and MARY DEMPSEY settled in Ameliasburgh Township, Prince Edward County. They purchased one-hundred acres of land from John Finkle and they were the second permanent settlers in Ameliasburgh Township. The Dempsey's next child, MARGARET, (born Oct. 24, 1790) was the third white child born in Ameliasburgh Township and the day after Margaret's birth Mary gathered up a few precious possessions along with some food and paddled across the Bay of Quinte to the 8th Town (Sidney) with her three young children and the new baby because of an Indian scare!

Many Loyalists were forced to leave their possessions behind when they came north and during the first few years they suffered a great deal of distress. The Loyalists in Ontario were given land grants free of fees in partial recognition of their losses and services during the American Revolution. THOMAS DEMPSEY petitioned for and was granted two-hundred acres of land on March 4th, 1816.

THOMAS DEMPSEY and his wife, MARY LAWSON had four daughters and three sons:

Information about THOMAS DEMPSEY and his wife, MARY LAWSON, and their connections came from the Loyalist records at Queen's University Archives in Kingston, records at the United Empire Loyalist Museum and Library at Adolphustown and Mr. William Allan Dempsey of Prince Edward County, a descendant of THOMAS DEMPSEY and his wife, MARY LAWSON.
