This is a preliminary effort to provide a compilation of data regarding Robert Hamilton of Sidney Township, Hastings County, Ontario and his descendants, a number of whom later resided in Marmora Township. A similar report has been generated on James Hamilton of Marmora Township and his descendants.

As of this date, I have been unable to establish the relationship between Robert and James, although they may have been either brothers or cousins, since available data do not provide us with the direct linkage between the two. Robert was born in Scotland of Irish extraction while James was born in the village of Clones in County Monaghan, Ireland.

Robert was living in Madoc Township at the time he acquired land in the 8th Concession of Sidney Township and his son, William Thomas Hamilton later settled in Marmora Township. James was an early settler in Marmora Township and both he and William Thomas Hamilton lived in the area known as North Marmora. When the wife of William Thomas Hamilton, Margaret Ann Morrow, died shortly after childbirth, she was the first burial in a small plot of land owned by James Hamilton. Similarly, subsequent generations of the North Marmora Hamiltons regarded themselves as related, but we will have to wait until further evidence emerges, to clearly establish the fact.

For now we will have to be content with the data on both families which have been gleaned from a variety of sources, and hope that over the coming years, additional supporting data will surface to provide us with a clearer picture of both families. This is a good starting point and I would hope that as the contents are reviewed by Hamilton descendants, that some will contact me in order to add additional pieces to the puzzle.

## *Descendants of Robert Hamilton*

### *Generation No. 1*

1. ROBERT<sup>2</sup> HAMILTON (*DAVID*<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1809 in Scotland<sup>1</sup>, and died 30 June 1887 in Sidney Township, Hastings County, Ontario<sup>2</sup>. He married HANNAH YOUNG Aft. 1835, daughter of CHRISTOPHER YOUNG and REBECCA. She was born Abt. 1808 in Fredericksburg, Lennox & Addington County, Ontario<sup>3</sup>, and died 05 December 1892 in Sidney Township, Hastings County, Ontario<sup>4</sup>.

#### Notes for ROBERT HAMILTON:

Robert acquired the deed for Lot 36, 8th Concession of Sidney Township on 11 March, 1847. He purchased the property from Joseph Card for 67 pounds 10 shillings. The deed states that Robert was a resident of Madoc Township at the time. He also received a Crown Patent to the E. half of Lot 36 on 9 November 1858. On 7 July 1873, Robert & Hannah conveyed 1.585 acres to the Grand Junction Railway Corporation, whose line ran across the southern portion of their property.

His tombstone inscription places his age at death as 78 years, which would confirm his year of birth as 1809.

While born in Scotland, the 1851 and subsequent censuses record his descent as Irish.

#### Notes for HANNAH YOUNG:

Mention should be made here of Hannah Young's family roots, which adds a bit of flair to the history of the family. She was the daughter of Christopher Young and Rebecca \_\_\_\_\_, who were raised in Fredericksburg, Lennox County. The Youngs were a United Empire Loyalist family of German extraction, who had come to America in 1710 from the Pallatines and ultimately settled at Rennsaelerwyck, a vast expanse of land on both sides of the Hudson River, east of Albany. Their farm was located a few miles south of Bennington, Vermont at Pownal in what was then part of the New York Colony. (The adjoining farm was owned by the Dafoe family, a name well known throughout southeastern Ontario, today.)

Hannah's grandfather, Henry Young, Jr. and her Great Grandfather, Henry Young, Sr. had both served in the Kings Royal Regiment at the Battle of Bennington and as a result, were labeled as "Tories" and had to flee to Sorrel, Quebec where the British Army was garrisoned. As Loyalists, they were ultimately awarded land grants at Fredericksburg, a few miles west of Kingston, Ontario.

It was at adjacent Ernestown (Bath area) that Henry and Eleanor Young's son, Christopher, was baptized on 12 January 1789 by the Reverend John Langhorn, the Anglican Missionary who ministered to the spiritual needs of the area's residents from 1787-1814. Christopher subsequently married Rebecca (Surname unknown) and their daughter, Hannah was baptised by Reverend Langhorn on 14 April 1811. (She was apparently the only child of this marriage because Rebecca died prior to 1814 and Christopher was remarried to Lany or Lana Kellar by 1815.)

On 27 November 1828, Hannah was married to Jacob Caldwell at St. Thomas Anglican Church in Belleville by the Rector, Reverend Thomas Campbell. Jacob was the son of John Caldwell and Julianna Miller of Ernestown. He had been baptized by Reverend Langhorn on 15 March 1789. (The Caldwells were also a U.E.L. family.)

Jacob and Hannah lived in Thurlow Township during their married years and at least three children were born to them, namely, James Sills Caldwell, born 22 February 1830, Julianna Caldwell, about 1832, and Eliza Ann Caldwell, about 1833. Then, on 7 September 1835, tragedy struck. As reported in the Cobourg Reformer of 15 September 1835, "We have just heard that a respectable farmer by the name of Caldwell, was stabbed in the street, at Belleville, on Monday afternoon, the 7th instant, by a man by the name of Watson, a gunsmith. It appears that there was some point of misunderstanding between a son of Watson's and Mr. Caldwell, about a horse, when the father came up to Caldwell and plunged a dagger in his side. Caldwell survived but a few hours and Watson has gone to Kingston, there to await his trial."

According to the Campbellford "Herald" Newspaper, George, who resided on the 7th Concessio of Sidney Township, was drowned in the Moira River, to the north-east of Foxboro, on the 22nd of July. He had gone fishing in the company of a 14 year old son of Stephen Fulton, on Joseph Waldron's property. He went out on some logs and when the logs began to roll, he lost his balance and tumbled into the water. He then drowned before help could arrive. He was survived by his wife, Hannah Isabella Hamilton and two young children, Herman, age 2 and Beatrice, aged 10 months.
