This is a preliminary effort to provide a compilation of data regarding James Hamilton of Marmora Township, Ontario and his descendants, who were among the early settlers of the area. A similar report has been generated on Robert Hamilton of Sidney Township and his descendants, including his son, William Thomas Hamilton, of Marmora Township

As of this date, I have been unable to establish the relationship between James and Robert, although they may have been brothers, or cousins, since available data do not provide us with the direct linkage between the two. James was born in the village of Clones, County Monaghan, Ireland while Robert's birthplace is simply given as "Scotland" although he is listed as being of Irish extraction.

James was an early settler in Marmora Township while Robert lived in Madoc Township before acquiring land in the 8th Concession of Sidney Township. Robert's son, William Thomas Hamilton, settled in Marmora Township and both he and James Hamilton resided in the area known as North Marmora. When the wife of William Thomas Hamilton, Margaret Ann Morrow, died shortly after childbirth, she was the first burial in a small plot of land owned by James Hamilton. Similarly, subsequent generations of the James and William Thomas sides of the family have regarded themselves as being related, but we will have to wait until further evidence emerges, to clearly establish the fact.

For now, we will have to be content with the data on both families which have been gleaned from a variety of sources, and hope that over the coming years, additional supporting data will emerge to provide us with a clearer picture of both families. This is a good starting point and I would hope that as the contents are reviewed by Hamilton descendants, that some will contact me in order to add additional pieces to the puzzle.

### Notes for JAMES HAMILTON:

The North Hastings Review (Madoc) of 17 March 1881 reported the funeral of the late James Hamilton, Esq., J.P. by saying that the funeral took place on the 10th inst., attended by relatives, friends and neighbors from Belleville and surrounding country, who followed their departed friend and neighbor to his last resting place. The 24 March issue of the Newspaper stated that as no sermon was preached at the funeral, on Sunday, the 13th inst., an appropriate and impressive discourse was delivered to a crowded audience by Rev. S. McCauley. James was obviously a person of some influence in the community since he was not only a local justice of the peace but had also served as the Reeve of Marmora in 1862, 1867 and 1868. Subsequent to his wife's death he relocated to Belleville where he presumably held a politically appointed position. He was living in Belleville at the time of his death.

James and Sarah farmed the property at Lot 16 of the 6th Concession, Marmora Township and it is at this site where the couple are buried in a small cemetery.

The North Hastings Review of 14 April 1881 reported on David Hamilton's narrow escape from injury or death as follows: "A tree from which the top was broken was being felled by him, and when it began to totter he tried to make his escape. The top went one way and the stub another, and as he fled he tripped and fell, the top just striking between his knees, throwing a shower of earth over him.

Birthdates for this family have been taken from the 1901 Census for Marmora Township. The Census indicates that David arrived in Canada in 1830, while Margaret arrived in 1850.

The Marmora Herald obituary of 7 December 1944 indicates that she was the last member of her family and was survived by nieces, Mrs. Frank Hicks of Corbyville and Mrs. Lillian Seeney of Toronto, as well as nephews, Ernest and Frank Chambers of Corbyville, Harry Chambers of Bath and Fred Hamilton, then serving overseas in the Armed Forces.

The North Hastings Review (Madoc) of 16 August 1877 reported the following: "A sad accident occurred near the Village of Marmora on Thursday last, about 4 o'clock, as Mrs. Thomas Hamilton, accompanied by Mrs. T. Howe and Miss Wells, were driving to the village, the wheel struck a stone, pitching Mrs. Hamilton over the side of the wagon, and dislocating her neck. Dr. Payne was at once summoned but could do nothing for the unfortunate woman, as she expired in a few minutes. She leaves a husband and nine children, for whom much sympathy is felt in their sad bereavement."

They erected a shack and by hard work cleared the land and made the fine farm where the late Mrs. Hamilton went as a bride and lived all her married life."

The newspaper obituary indicates that her daughter, Mrs. T.C. Hutchings of Picton, Ontario and Mrs. James Kennedy of Cordova, in addition to her two sons, survived her.

On Friday evening, 23 February 1906, a group of about 50 friends and neighbors held a farewell dinner for the couple and presented them with a number of gifts. Presenters included Mrs. Charles Carman (Jennie) and Mrs. F. Burkitt. After the supper was completed, Mr. Wiley Hamilton took the chair and hosted the event.

At the time of his marriage, James was listed as being 35 years of age, which is in contrast to his birthdate as shown in the 1901 Census. The 1901 Census indicates that James came to Canada in 1868.

I have fond recollections of Clarence since I would see him occasionally at my Grandmother, Rose Derry's farm when he would come to pick up cattle that he had purchased from Grandma. He was always pleasant to me as a youngster and Grandmother Derry thought highly of him, feeling that he was an honest man that could be thoroughly trusted in business dealings. We were all saddened by his untimely death. I remeber one weekend afternoon when Clarence, Emma and their teo sons, John and Milton came to call on mom and dad, while we were vacationing at Grandmas's. While the folks were inside visiting, the two boys and I gathered green apples from one of the trees and ran into the outhouse, of all places, to eat them, since we had been warned of the potential ill effects of eating apples before they were ripe. As we munched away, we kept glancing out of the window to make sure that none of the adults had spotted us. That evening after out guests had left, I kept wondering if and when I would get sick and was relieved upon awakening the next morning , to find that I had suffered no ill effects from the experience. I never found out whether John and Milton had escaped with similar good fortune.

Clarence was always called "Whit" by his father and some of the other friends and relatives. Audrey Kelly recalls that he had extremely bright, blue eyes.
